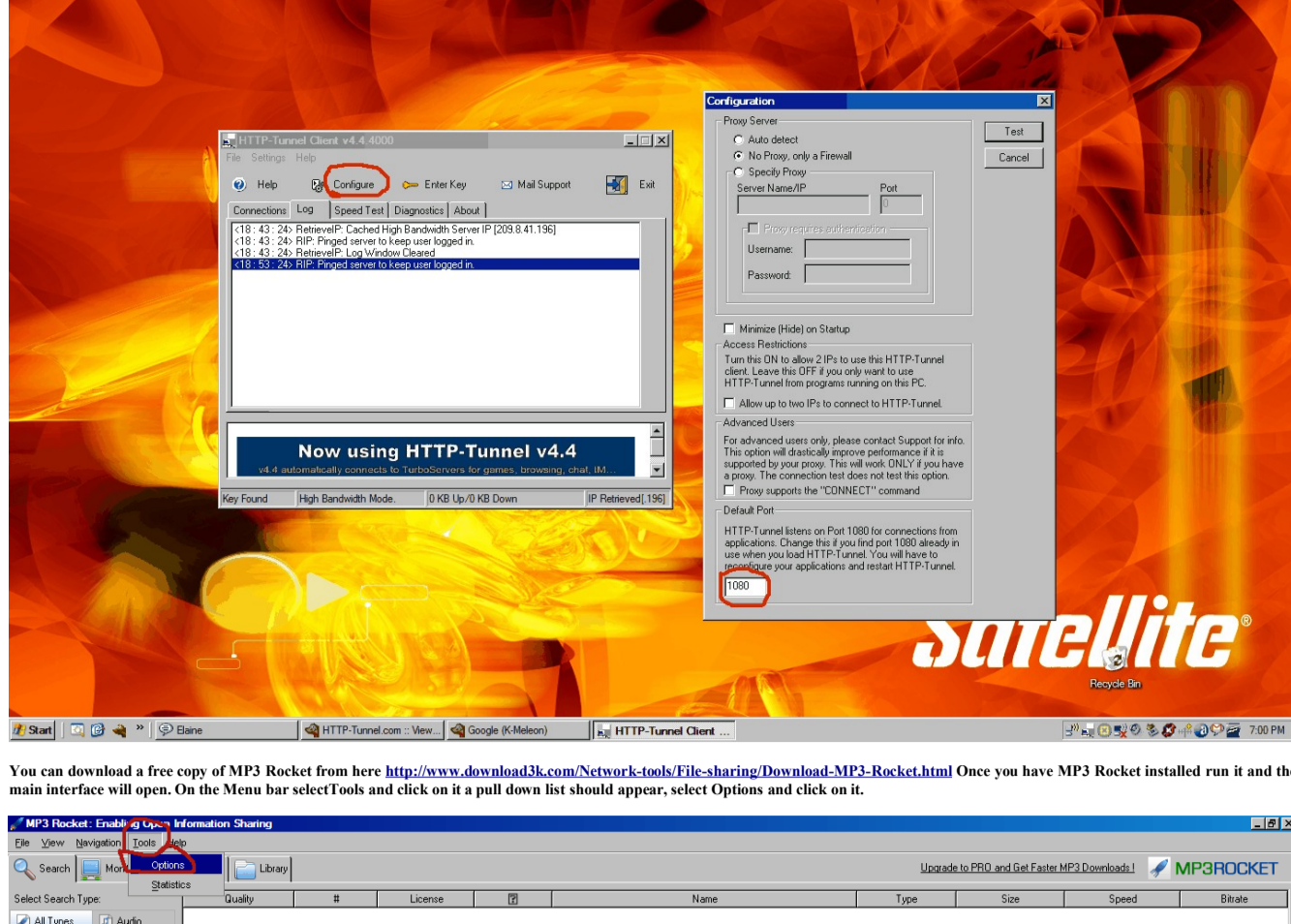


This guide will show you how to configure MP3 Rocket to use Http-Tunnel. This guide is only for configuring MP3 Rocket to use the Http-Tunnel Client. [Http-Tunnel does not give technical support for this product.](#)

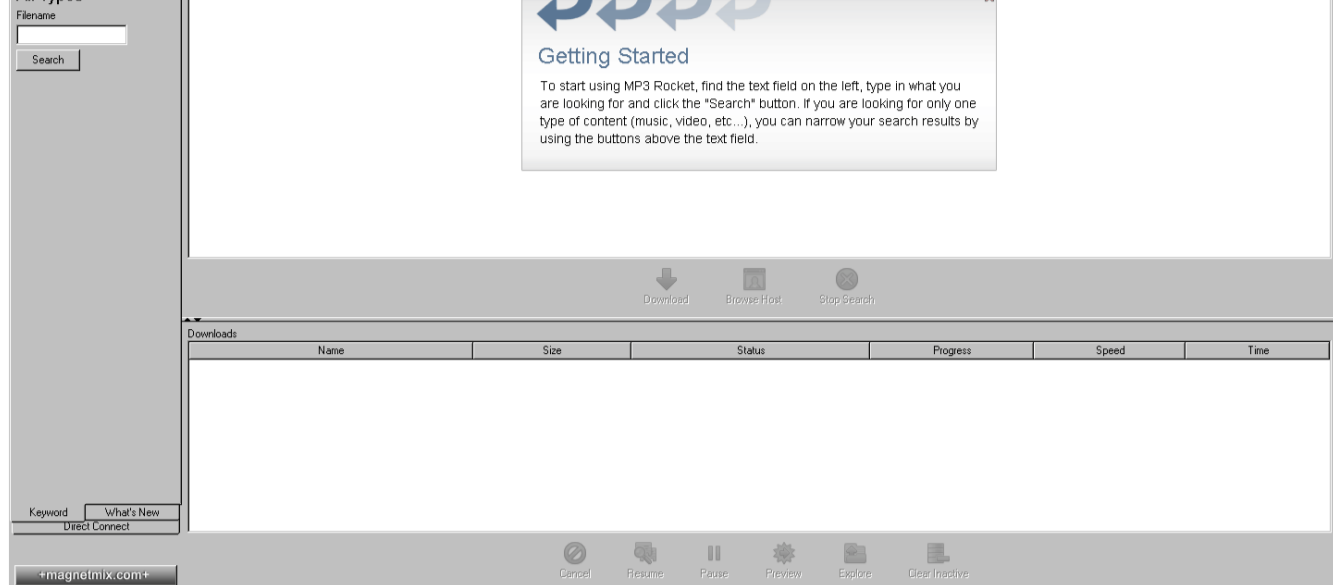
Once you have Http-Tunnel installed, run the application. The main window will appear, choose the configure option. There you will be presented with three (3) options.

1. You can Select Auto detect if you want Http-Tunnel to detect your settings.
2. No Proxy only a firewall if this is appropriate.
3. Specify Proxy, Here you will enter the IP address and Port number of the proxy that you use.

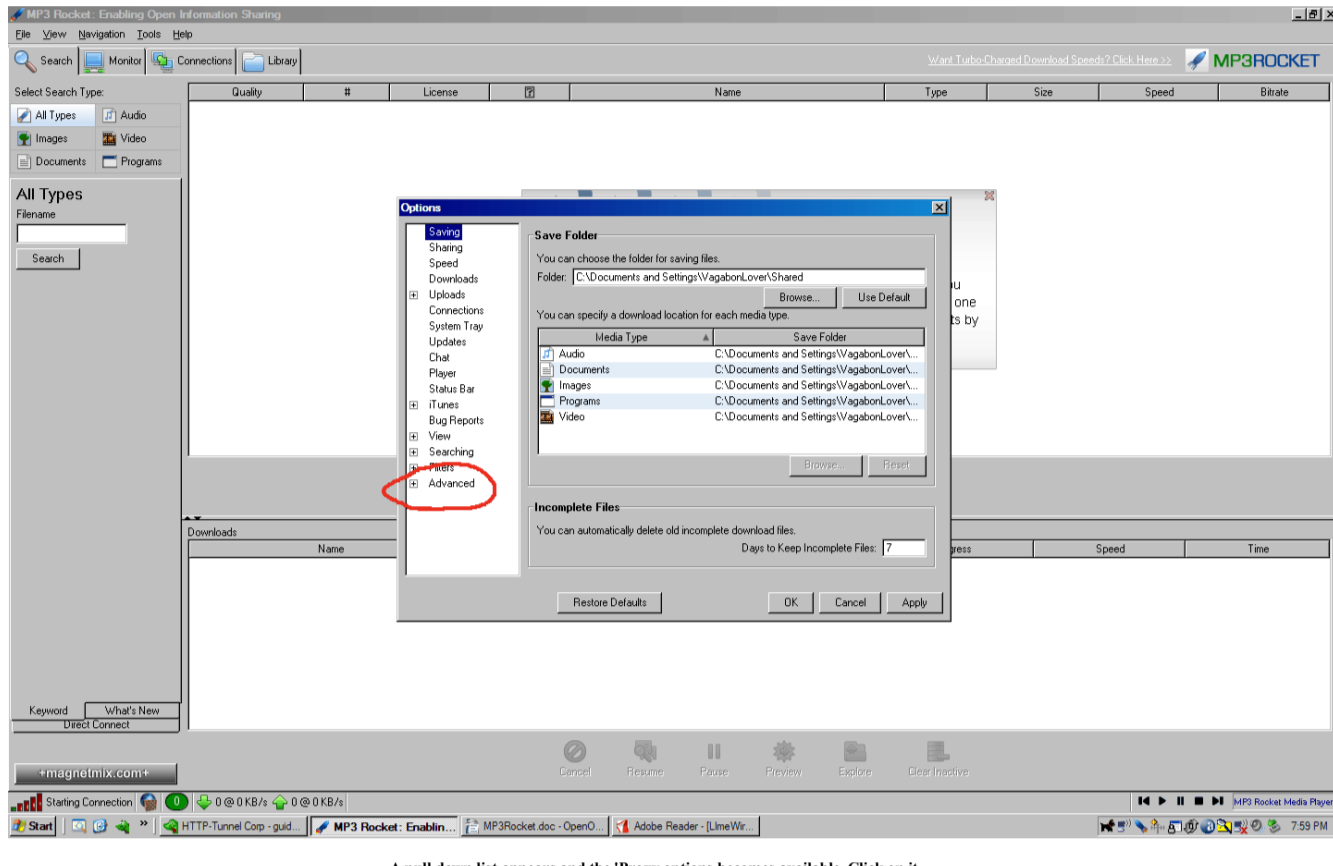
Complete 1 of the 3 options, then click test, the client will bind to port 1080 and localhost by default and connect to the tunnel servers if your settings are correct.



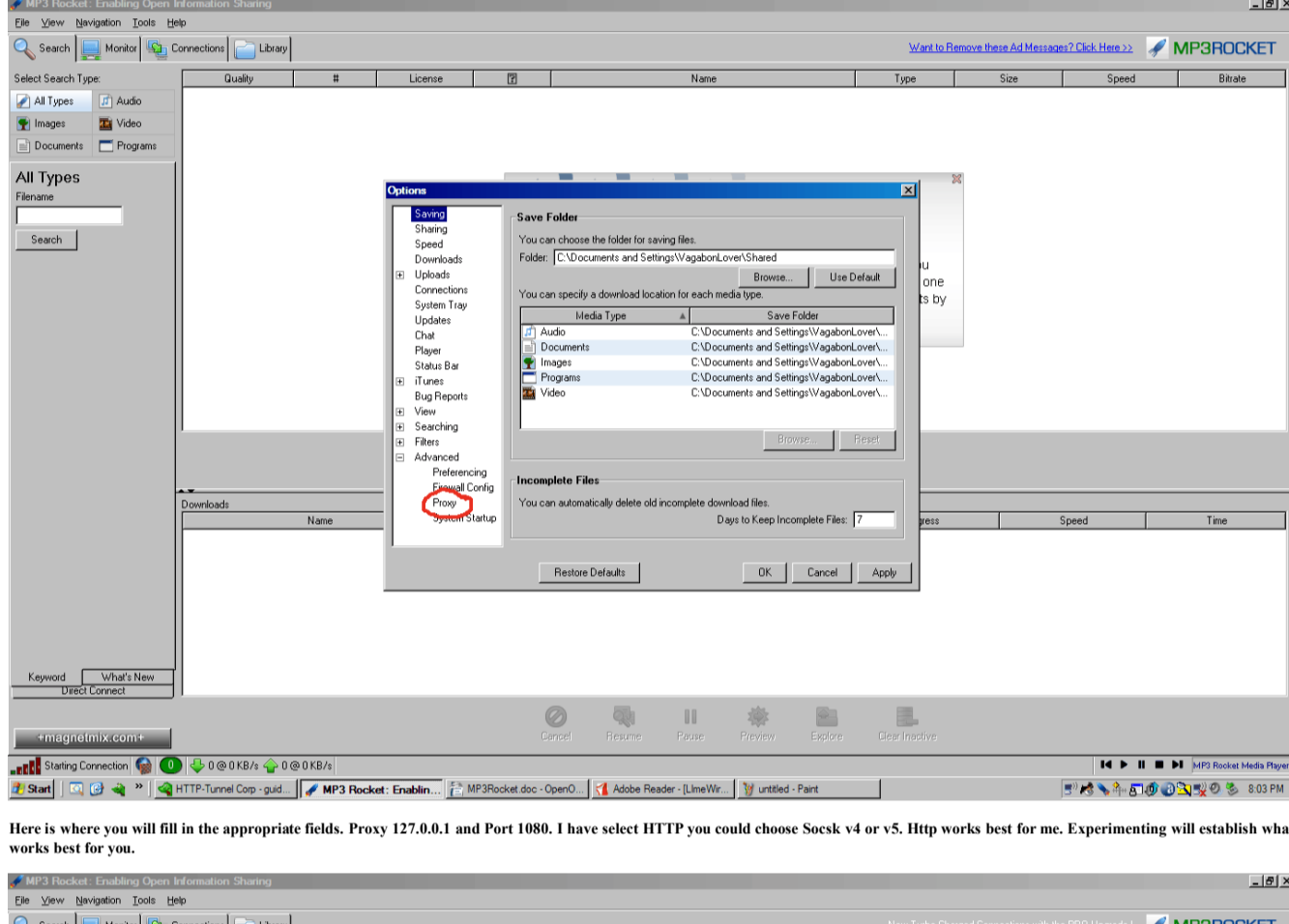
You can download a free copy of MP3 Rocket from here <http://www.download3k.com/Network-tools/File-sharing/Download-MP3-Rocket.html> Once you have MP3 Rocket installed run it and the main interface will open. On the Menu bar select Tools and click on a pull down list should appear, select Options and click on it.



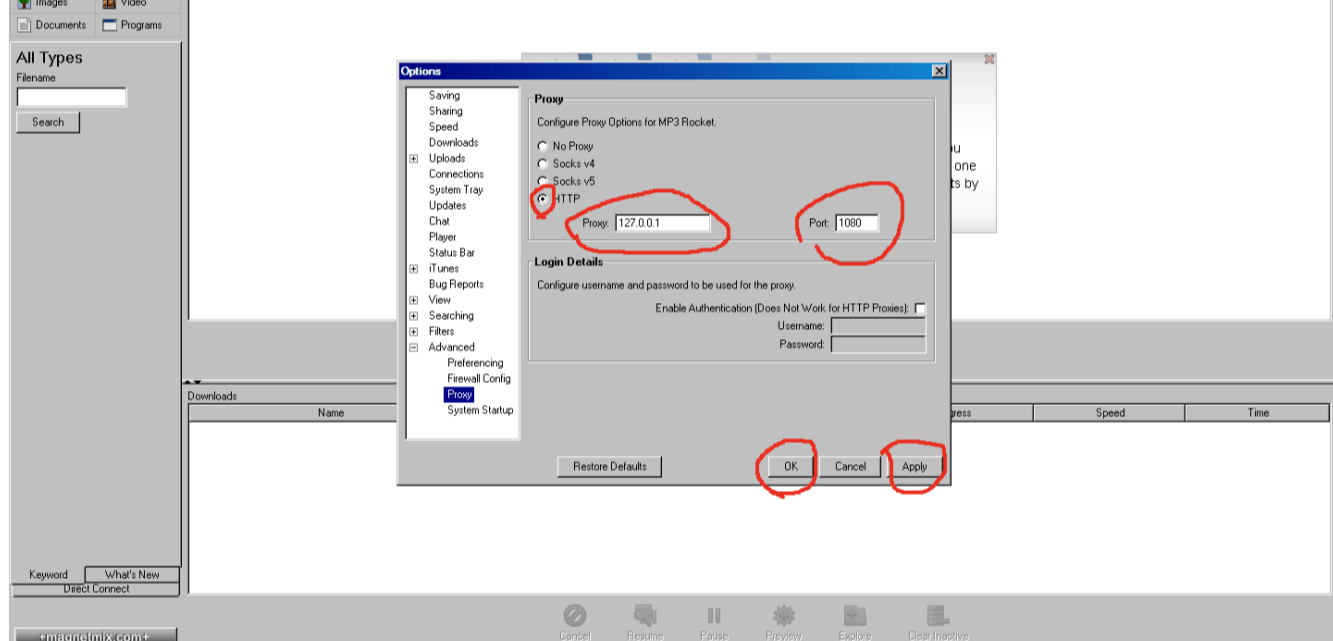
The Options dialogue box should appear. Scroll down to Advanced and click on it.



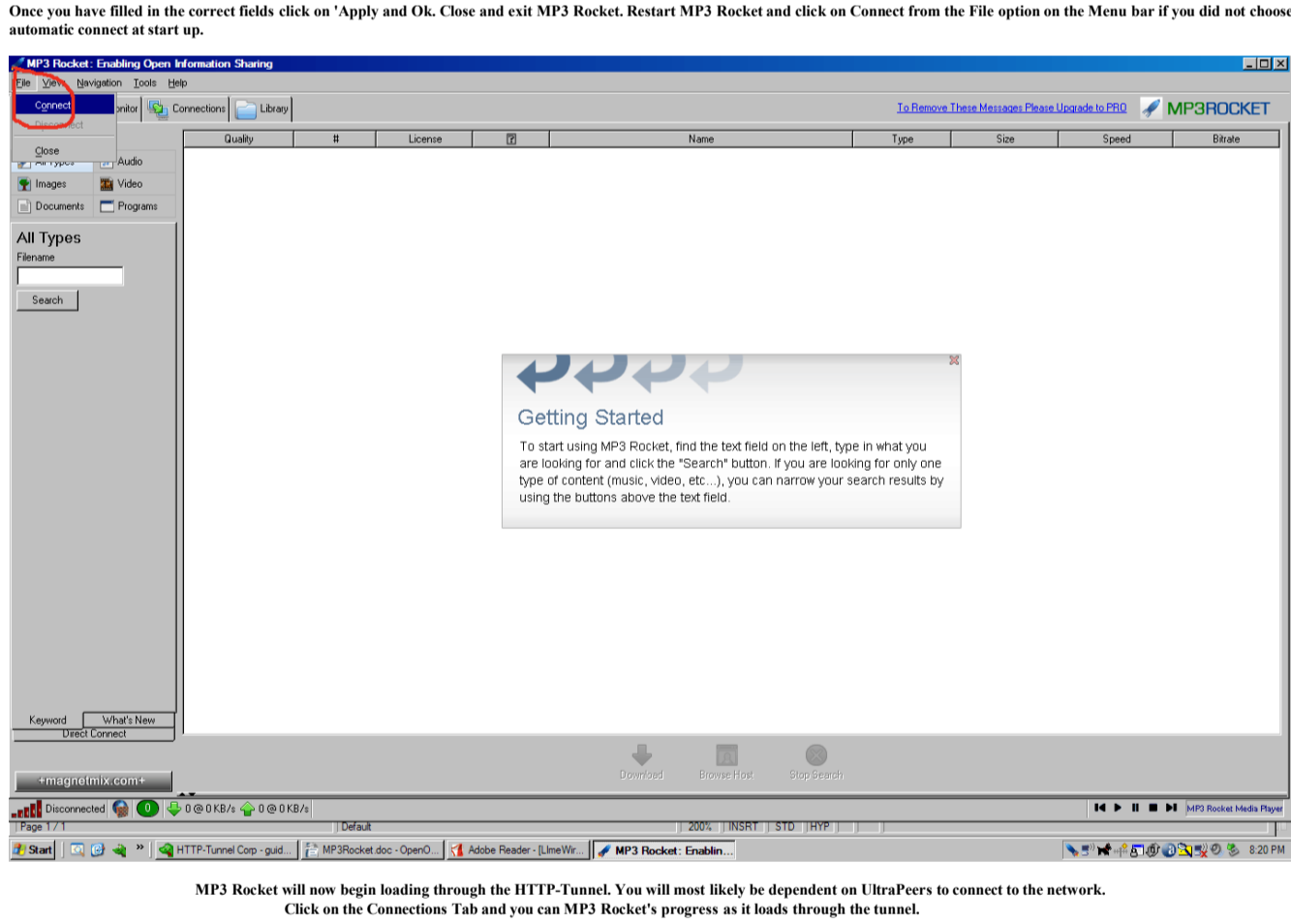
A pull down list appears and the Proxy options becomes available. Click on it.



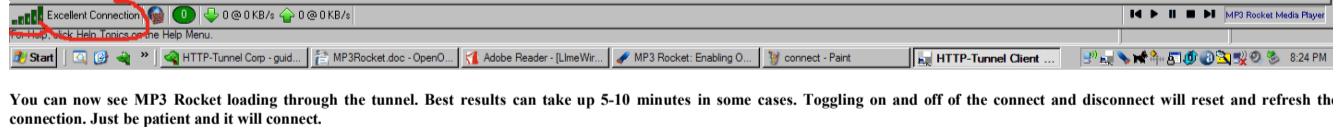
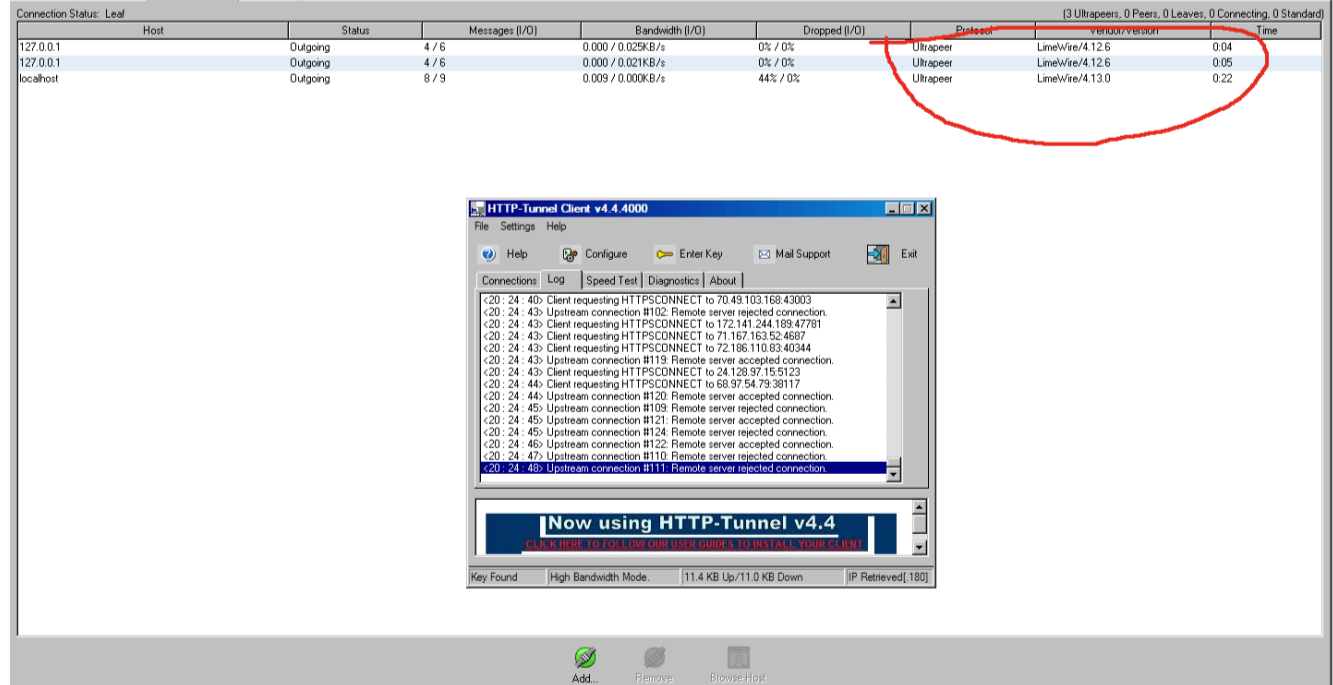
Here is where you will fill in the appropriate fields. Proxy 127.0.0.1 and Port 1080. I have select HTTP you could choose Sock v4 or v5. Http works best for me. Experimenting will establish what works best for you.



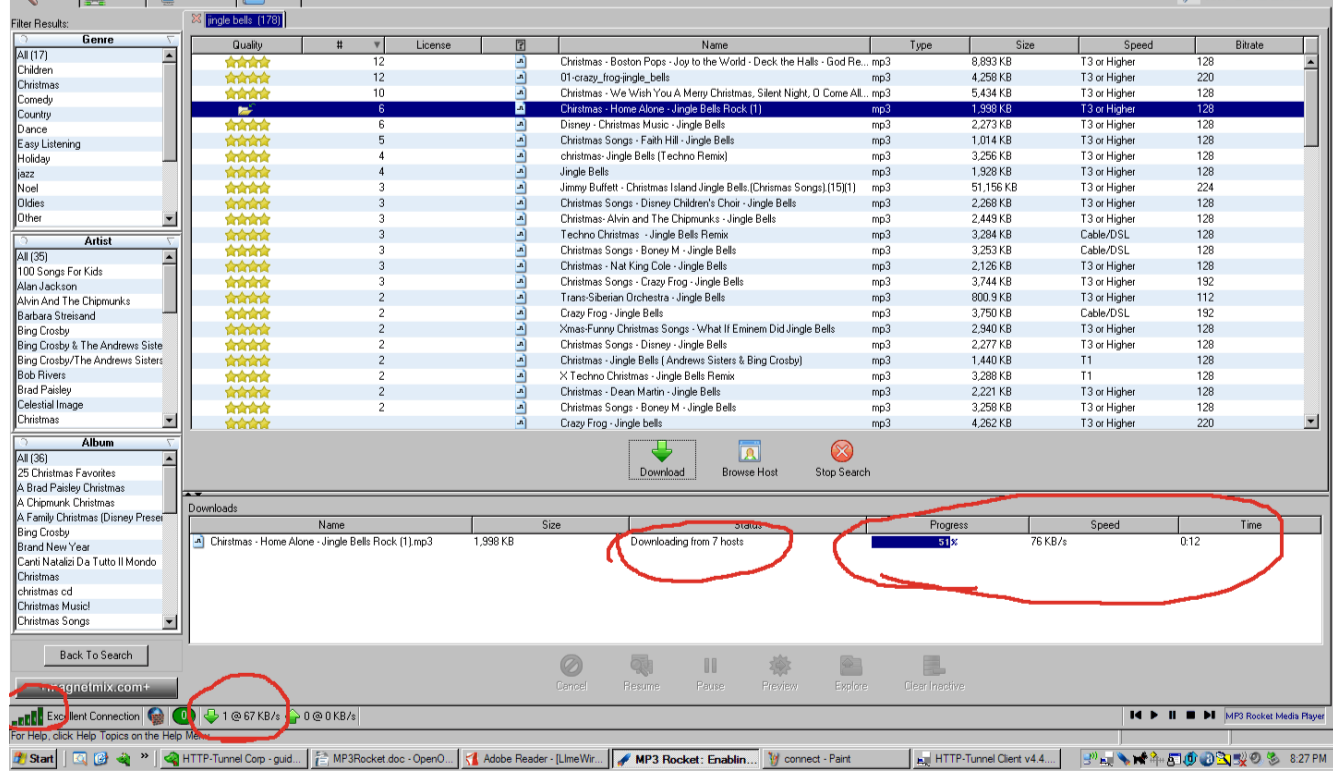
Once you have filled in the correct fields click on 'Apply and Ok. Close and exit MP3 Rocket. Restart MP3 Rocket and click on Connect from the File option on the Menu bar if you did not choose automatic connect at start up.



MP3 Rocket will now begin loading through the HTTP-Tunnel. You will most likely be dependent on UltraPeers to connect to the network. Click on the Connections Tab and you can MP3 Rocket's progress as it loads through the tunnel.



You can now see MP3 Rocket loading through the tunnel. Best results can take up 5-10 minutes in some cases. Toggling on and off of the connect and disconnect will reset and refresh the connection. Just be patient and it will connect.
